IMAGE CHECKLIST

- For all photographs it is key that they are sharp and clear.
- In particular, the images of the engine and frame number must show all of the digits and they must be clear to read. If necessary, try alternative lighting angles to make clearer. Where images are not clear it may lead to delays in processing.
- Where frames have been painted (especially with powder coating) it may be necessary to carefully remove the paint in that area so that the frame number can be identified.
- Files which are used for online applications should be limited in size to fit within mailbox sizes – ideally, they should be less than 1 MB (1000 kB) each. For Windows users, this can be done in “Photos” app, using “Resize Image”. Similar functions are available on other platforms / Apps. Ensure the images remain clear and numbers can be read clearly.
